First Shillelagh Gold Award Recipient

Sr. Mary Edward was the first woman to receive this prestigious award from the Emerald Club in 1987. As the longest living Shillelagh Award Recipient, she was honored at the Emerald Club Gala this year and was presented the first ever Golden Shillelagh Award.

Since 1960 when the doors opened at Mercy Centre, Sister Mary Edward was there for the celebration. As Principal and then Administrator, devoting her heart and soul to Mercy Centre. Sister was a strong presence at Mercy Centre for over forty-two years. She instilled values, acceptance, and inspired students and staff to work harder. Growth continued year after year under her leadership and the programs thrived. She was a strong presence, admired, respected and loved by all that came in contact with her. A pioneer of her time, a leader that never needed accolades, a mentor that dedicated her life to teaching.

Sister Mary Edward was admired, respected and loved by all that came in contact with her. The qualities that she possessed, inspired many people to be passionate about their work and committed to people with disabilities. The journey may be a struggle, although with resilience, hope, and prayers the outcome amounts to endless possibilities.
